Externally funded awards totaled \$9,780,944.

Highlights of FY15 include:

- Proposals submitted for consideration of future awards totaled \$17,418,766
- 108 proposals were submitted; 88 were proposals requesting new funds
- 88 proposals were awarded
- 51 Principal Investigators (PIs) submitted proposals (with 9 being new PIs)
- \$947,441 in indirect costs was generated
